

Waste Removal Do's and Don'ts

Dumpsters

1. General household waste must be bagged and secured
2. Corrugated cardboard must be broken down and placed beside dumpster
3. Yard waste must be bagged and secured
4. Recyclables
 - a. Glass
 - b. Plastic
 - c. Newspaper
 - d. Mixed Office Paper
 - e. Magazines

Must be taken to the east campus drop off site at the end of 6th St.

5. UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- a. Cardboard
- b. Couches
- c. Chairs
- d. Tables
- e. Carpet
- f. Tree branches / trunks
- g. Car parts
- h. Construction materials (i.e. wood, brick, stone, concrete)
- i. Desks
- j. Dirt
- k. Sand
- l. Hot coals
- m. Mattresses
- n. Bed frames

Roll Offs

1. Bulky items are acceptable

2. ACCEPTED ITEMS

- a. Furniture
- b. Carpet
- c. Mattresses
- d. Dirt
- e. Construction Materials
- f. Tree branches / Trunks (Max length 4ft.)
- g. Sand
